P1 Updates (2/2026)

1. Settling into Primary School

After Term 1, we have seen many of our Primary 1 students gradually adjust to the routines and expectations of primary school life. It is encouraging to see many of them making new friends and participating actively in class. While some students have blended in very well, we recognise that others may still need a little more time and support as they continue their transition into primary school. The school will continue to guide and support our students and we look forward to working closely with parents to ensure that every child feels confident and comfortable in school.

2. School-Home Partnership

a) Communication with Teachers

The Parents Gateway is a one-stop portal that strengthens school-home partnership to support our children in their education journey. All school announcements and consent forms are disseminated via the PG. We strongly encourage all parents/guardians to read and respond to the notifications in PG.

Students are also advised to bring their Student Handbook to school on every school day. They have been guided and reminded by their teachers to record in their handbooks their daily assignments and the instructions given by teachers. Parents may refer to the handbook to get an update on your child's/ward's daily assignments and the instructions given by their teachers.

b) Establishing a positive school-home partnership

To help Primary 1 students develop self-management skills and responsibility, the following important reminders were shared with them. We seek your partnership in reinforcing these habits at home:

- Safe play and building positive relationships with their peers
- Spending pocket money wisely
- Taking care of their valuables
- Eating a well-balanced diet
- Toilet etiquette
- Use of a daily schedule and managing screen time

3. Term 2 Check-in Survey

The Check-in survey, administered by MOE in every term, allows teachers to monitor and support students' well-being. Each student has been given their MIMS account login details to access the All Ears Portal where they can complete the Termly Check-in survey. For term 2, the survey will be assigned at the end of the term. Please assist your child/ward to log in and remind them that their MIMS password constitutes personal data and should be treated with utmost confidentiality, not to be shared with anyone. Please refer to the attached Appendix for the step-by-step guide for the login. Should you encounter any issues logging in, you may reach out to your child/ward's Form Teacher for assistance.
