School Assessment Policy

We would like to remind you of the school assessment policy:

- There will be no make-up assessment for students who are absent on days of the Weighted Assessment.
- Students who are on unwell are required to produce their Medical Certificate (MC) or a letter from their parents immediately upon their return to school. Their overall marks at the end of the year will be pro-rated accordingly.
- Students participating in National Sports Games (NSG) will be allowed to sit for the paper either earlier or later on the day of the assessment if the time permits. Otherwise, their overall marks will be pro-rated accordingly. Students will be given the WA paper as practice and teachers will provide the necessary feedback.

2. Term 2 Check-in Survey

The Check-in survey, administered by MOE in every term, allows teachers to monitor and support students' well-being. Each student has been given their MIMS account login details to access the All Ears Portal where they can complete the Termly Check-in survey. For term 2, the survey will be assigned at the end of the term.
