School Assessment Policy

We would like to remind you of the school assessment policy:

- Students must sit for each paper strictly according to the date and time stipulated in the examination timetable.
- There will be no make-up papers for students who are absent on examination days.
- Students who are ill or are covered by medical certificates* (MC) on the day of the paper are not allowed to sit for it.
- Students who are on medical leave are required to produce their MC immediately upon their return to school. Their marks will be computed accordingly. No marks will be awarded for the paper if there are no supporting MC.

** Parents who wish for their child to take the papers during the period covered by MC must produce doctor's memo to certify that the child is fit for school.*
