P1 Updates (4/2026)

1) Edusave Merit Bursary

In line with the removal of all weighted assessments for Primary 1 and Primary 2 students, MOE has revised the academic criteria for Edusave Merit Bursary (EMB) and Edusave Good Progress Award (GPA) at the lower primary levels. P1 Singaporean students in Government and Government-aided schools can be nominated by teachers for the Edusave Merit Bursary if they consistently demonstrated positive learning dispositions in the course of the year. Learning dispositions are positive behaviours and attitudes towards learning. In Ngee Ann Primary School, we recognize students who are A.C.T.I.V.E in learning. There are six key learning dispositions that the school seeks to develop in every child. Please refer to the table below.

Appreciative	• Recognises that everyone has different and unique qualities • Listens to views of others and accepts them
Curious	• Willing to explore new things • Asks questions that show further thinking
Tenacious	• Perseveres to do his or her personal best in completing a task • Does not give up easily when the problem is difficult
Initiative	• Acts on feedback and uses it to improve performance • Shares personal responses that contribute to discussions
Versatile	• Able to work independently and in groups • Is open to try new or different ideas
Engaged	• Shows keen interest in learning • Is focus and attentive during lessons
