P2 Updates (4/2026)

1) Edusave Merit Bursary

In line with the removal of all weighted assessments for Primary 1 and Primary 2 students, MOE has revised the academic criteria for Edusave Merit Bursary (EMB) and Edusave Good Progress Award (GPA) at the lower primary levels. P2 Singaporean students in Government and Government-aided schools can be nominated by teachers for the Edusave Merit Bursary if they consistently demonstrated positive learning dispositions in the course of the year. Learning dispositions are positive behaviours and attitudes towards learning. In Ngee Ann Primary School, we recognize students who are A.C.T.I.V.E in learning. There are six key learning dispositions that the school seeks to develop in every child. Please refer to the table below.

Dispositions	Actions
Appreciative	• Recognises that everyone has different and unique qualities • Listens to views of others and accepts them
Curious	• Willing to explore new things • Asks questions that show further thinking
Tenacious	• Perseveres to do his or her personal best in completing a task • Does not give up easily when the problem is difficult
Initiative	• Acts on feedback and uses it to improve performance • Shares personal responses that contribute to discussions
Versatile	• Able to work independently and in groups • Is open to try new or different ideas
Engaged	• Shows keen interest in learning • Is focus and attentive during lessons

2) P2 CCA Carnival

The school will be organising a CCA Carnival for all P2 students on Wednesday, 21 October 2026. Various CCA groups will showcase their CCA booths at the Indoor Sports Hall (ISH), led

by respective CCA Student Leaders. This is to enable the current batch of P2 students to make a more informed decision before committing to a particular CCA in P3. You will then be required to submit your child's top 3 choices online via a link on Parents Gateway. Students currently with a CCA will still participate in the carnival but need not submit the online form. More details will be given in a separate letter.

3) Learning Journey

In line with our English Language Term 4 theme, "Enjoying the Outdoors", our Primary 2 students will embark on an educational field trip to Bird Paradise. This outdoor learning experience offers a unique opportunity for students to engage directly with nature while studying diverse bird species and their natural habitats. It will also offer them a meaningful glimpse into their learning in Science, which they will begin in Primary 3 next year.

Through close-up observation, children will gain valuable insights into animal welfare and environmental conservation. We aim to foster a deeper appreciation for wildlife and encourage a lasting interest in the natural world.

4) Little Voices Big Discoveries

We are excited to continue "Little Voices Big Discoveries", an initiative that provides Primary 1 and 2 students with opportunities to share interesting knowledge with their peers during pre-assembly. Students may present on any topic of interest, such as hobbies, current affairs or fascinating facts, using slides, show-and-tell items or videos.

As we were unable to accommodate all interested students last term, those who had previously signed up will be given priority to present this term. If your child/ward is keen to participate, kindly indicate his/her interest via the following link <https://go.gov.sg/naps-p1p2sharingsem2>.

Students may prepare their sharing using slides, show-and-tell items, or videos, with parental guidance. Thereafter, the sharing materials will be uploaded to the Singapore Student Learning Space (SLS) and projected on a large screen during the student's sharing. The confirmed sharing schedule will be communicated to parents via Parent Gateway (PG).

5) Transition from Primary 2 to Primary 3

As we approach the end of the school year, we would like to seek your partnership and support in preparing your child's transition to Primary 3.

In line with our holistic approach, class allocation will be thoughtfully managed based on students' readiness and learning pace. Class dynamics are also carefully considered to help students integrate smoothly, form new friendships, and develop a stronger sense of belonging in their new classroom environment.

Moving up to Primary 3 brings new experiences and learning opportunities, such as introducing Science as a new subject and increased content demands across all subjects.
