4. Subject-based Banding (SBB)

Subject-based Banding is an initiative by the Ministry of Education (MOE) to provide a balanced education that caters to the children's differing abilities. 5. P4 Learning Journey to the Kreta Ayer Heritage Gallery

This year, our P4 students will be going on a learning journey to the Kreta Ayer Heritage Gallery to better understand the contributions made by the Chinese community in the development of Singapore. During the tour, they will be taking part in a precinct walk as well as a tour of the gallery. The activities and demonstrations in the tour will engage the students in applying their field work skills, such as asking questions and gathering data through observations and stories.
