## COMMUNICATION 2/2026

Dear Parents/Guardians,

As Term 1 concludes, we would like to share the following updates and important information for Term 2:

### 1. **86<sup>th</sup> Founder's Day Celebration - Monday, 30 March 2026**

The school will be celebrating our 86<sup>th</sup> Founder's Day on **Monday, 30 March 2026**. With the theme of Gratitude, we remember the vision and dedication of our founders who laid the strong foundation of our school. Their commitment to building and nurturing the community has shaped generations of students. We honour their legacy and express our heartfelt appreciation, as we continue to grow, learn, and uphold the values they established for the future. As part of the celebration, students will take part in engaging activities to express their appreciation and learn more about the contributions of our founders.

Please note that school hours will be curtailed on that day. Students will be dismissed at 10.00am, and there will be no CCAs scheduled that afternoon. Our school bus vendors and school-based SCC have been informed about the early dismissal. Students going home by school bus will be transported at 10.00am. Ace @ Work Student Care Centre will operate from 10.00am to 7.00pm on that day.

### 2. **Temperature-Taking Exercise - Wednesday, 1 April 2026**

The temperature-taking exercise will be conducted on **Wednesday, 1 April 2026**. This exercise aims to maintain schools' preparedness to re-activate the temperature-taking regime should there be a need to. It also serves to educate students to take personal responsibility for their own health and practise social responsibility.

As part of the school's preparation for the exercise, we will be conducting a pre-exercise check on Oral Digital Thermometers (ODTs) on Tuesday, 31 March 2026. We would like to seek your assistance in ensuring that your child/ward brings his/her personal ODT on the two days mentioned.

### 3. **International Friendship Day - Tuesday, 7 April 2026**

This year, International Friendship Day will be commemorated on **Tuesday, 7 April 2026**, with the theme "Singapore: Forging Friendships in a Complex World".

As the global landscape evolves, Singapore faces both opportunities and challenges. International cooperation remains vital for addressing global issues and seizing new opportunities. By fostering an appreciation for diverse cultures and perspectives, students will be better equipped to contribute to a cohesive and globally connected society and deepen their understanding of Singapore's geopolitical realities and national interests.

On that day, our students will participate in CCE lessons and related activities designed to help them embrace these important values. There will be recess activities held together with the EL Week to provide more opportunities for our students to engage in meaningful activities that reflect the values of international friendship, communication and cultural understanding.

**4. English Language (EL) Week - Tuesday, 7 April to Friday, 10 April 2026**

EL Week is a school-wide programme designed to spark students' interest in the language through activities such as reading, storytelling and creative expression. Centred on the theme "Stories That Connect Us", EL Week 2026 invites students from all primary levels to explore stories and cultures from neighbouring ASEAN countries through engaging activities and books.

Held in collaboration with the school's International Friendship Day, the programme aims to help students appreciate regional cultures while building confidence in communication and performance. Through interactive recess activity booths, storytelling experiences and level-based books, students will discover how stories can connect people, cultures and communities.

The week encourages students to develop a love for reading, express themselves creatively, and gain a deeper understanding of the diverse cultures within the ASEAN region.

**5. P5 Parents' Briefing – Friday, 10 April 2026**

There will be a face-to-face briefing for P5 parents on **Friday, 10 April 2026** from 2.30pm to 4.00pm in your child's/ ward's respective classrooms. The class subject teachers for English, Mathematics, Science and Mother Tongue will share curriculum matters and strategies on how parents can support their child's learning. Closer to the date, a follow-up letter will be sent via PG with registration details and a more detailed programme for the briefing.

**6. Be A Fabulous Friend (B.F.F) Week – Tuesday, 14 April to Thursday, 16 April 2026**

B.F.F. Week is a special week dedicated to reminding everyone what it means to be a truly fabulous friend! Throughout the week, exciting recess activities will be organised for students to enjoy themselves with their friends. These activities encourage kindness, teamwork, appreciation, and caring for one another. As students play, laugh, and participate together, they will also learn simple ways to show friendship and make our school a happier place for everyone.

**7. Kindness 2.0 – Tuesday, 12 May to Thursday, 14 May 2026**

Every year, the school commemorates Kindness the NAPS way through Kindness 2.0 – during which students learn and show kindness behaviors! Like the previous year, we will be combining Cyber Wellness and Kindness@NAPS into one exciting initiative – being good neighbours both online and offline! During assembly, students will learn more about neighbourliness and showing kindness through their daily actions and words. During recess, students will get to take part in fun, interactive activities that highlight the importance of:

- The value of kindness and how it aligns with NAPS school value of respect.
- Being a kind and thoughtful friend—in school and online!
- Showing good neighborliness in the school environment and being good role models.
- Using words wisely when chatting in the cyber world.
- Staying alert to online scams.
- Being responsible digital citizens while having fun online!

**8. Arts Fest 2026 – Thursday, 28 May 2026**

As part of the school's Learning for Life Programme (LLP), **GR**owing **A**ppreciation for **C**reative **E**xpression (**GRACE**), all students will have the opportunity to immerse themselves in the vibrancy of the arts at NAPS on **Thursday, 28 May 2026** as we mark the end of a fruitful first semester.

Students will begin the day with an exciting line-up of performances by their peers.
