Information for P1 (2026) Parents/Guardians

1. School Terms

1.1 The school terms for 2026 will be as follows:

- 1.2 All Primary 1 (P1) student will start school on **Friday**, **2 Jan 2026**.
- 1.3 All students must attend school regularly and punctually during the school term.

2. School Hours

2.1 The usual school hours are as follows:

However, please take note that all P1 students will be dismissed as follows for the following dates as stated below:

2.2 There will be a 5 to 10-minute snack break for students in the classrooms between 12 noon and 12.30 pm. This is part of the school's effort to improve student well-being. Students are encouraged to consume dry healthy snacks (e.g. nuts, dried fruit and fruit snack bars) that are of reasonable portion. Sharing snacks is not allowed due to personal hygiene.

3. Commuting To and From School

3.1 Parents/Guardians who drive your child/ward to school are to be considerate and refrain from holding up the traffic when your child alight from the car. Ensure that your child/ward is seated on the left side of the car with his/her school bag. Do not

alight your child/ward along Marine Terrace, in front of the bus stop. Alight your child at the designated drop off carparks at Block 4, Block 5 or Block 50A.

- 3.2 Parents/Guardians who walk your child/ward to school are encouraged to send them to Gate 1 or 4. We urge parents to move away from the gate areas quickly to allow other parents to drop their child/ward off. This is to prevent congestion at the gates and ensure safety of the students crossing outside the school gate and facilitate movement of cars turning into the school compound.
- 3.3 Parents/Guardians who are picking your children/wards during school dismissal, are to wait for them <u>outside Gate 4</u>. For students who need to wait for their <u>siblings</u>, <u>a designated corner at the parade square</u> will be provided for them to wait for one another after dismissal.
- 3.4 Students who commute to and from school by <u>bicycle or scooter</u> may register and park their bicycles or scooters at the waiting area near Gate 4. If you plan for your child/ward to commute to and from school by bicycle or scooter, please complete the registration form via this link by 30 December 2025.

Registered students will be required to attend a safety briefing at the start of the school year. Do note that parking within the school is at your own risk and is granted on a first-come, first-served basis, as parking spaces are limited. Students with successful registration will receive a label, which must be affixed to their bicycle or scooter for identification purposes.

Students who cycle or ride a scooter to school must:

- Label, secure and lock their bicycles and scooters at all times.
- Dismount and push their bicycles or scooters while within the school compound.
- Observe road safety when riding on pedestrian pathways and designated areas.
- Refrain from using mobile phones and earphones while riding.
- Always wear protective gear and check that their bicycles and scooters are in good working condition.


4.2 Please ensure the name and class of your child/ward are written clearly on all the books, files and materials.



- 4.3 Your child/ward is to bring the following items to school every day starting from the first day of school:
 - Lanyard nametag (Complete the information on the name tag.)
 - Stationery (pencils, eraser, ruler, pencil sharpener, colour pencils)
 - Story book for silent reading before flag raising Odd week: English Language Book
 - Even week: Mother Tongue Language Book
 - Water bottle
 - Snack for snack break
 - Pocket money (\$2.50 \$3 a day for recess should be sufficient.)
 - Oral digital thermometer (Thermometer will be distributed to your child on 2 Jan 2026. Please ensure that your child brings the thermometer daily.)
 - Please ensure that your child's iron-on name tag is attached securely above the school crest to help us identify your child easily
